2009 Barry M. Moriarty Graduate Paper Competition

Annually, the Southern Regional Science Association awards a cash prize to the student submitting the best paper in the area of Regional Science. The following qualifications apply:

- The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited academic institution sometime during the year following April, 2009;
- The student must be sponsored by a member of SRSA; and
- The winning student will present the paper at a session of the SRSA annual meetings, April 2-4, 2009 in San Antonio, TX, using the award to defray costs of attending.

Papers must be double-spaced, no more than 25 pages in length, and written in the style of the *Review of Regional Studies*. The cover page should include: the paper's title; the author's full name, address, and telephone numbers; similar information for the sponsor, and an abstract of 100-150 words.
