The 3rd Annual SRSA Undergraduate Poster Session will take place during the 2019 SRSA Annual Meeting, April 4-6, 2019, at the Key Bridge Marriott in Arlington, VA, right outside of Washington, DC.

This is a great opportunity for undergraduate students to present their research. While the SRSA is a regional organization for the advancement of regional science, in the interest of expanding the pool of future researchers, we will consider a broad range of research topics.

Each participating undergraduate student will be expected to prepare an academic poster and give a 3- to 5-minute oral presentation about his/her research. Other activities to enhance the experience for the students are also planned.
