The 4th Annual SRSA Undergraduate Poster Session will take place during the 2024 SRSA Annual Meeting, April 4-6, 2024, at the Crystal Gateway Marriott, Arlington, Virginia (near Washington, DC).

**This is a great opportunity for undergraduate students to present their research.** While the SRSA is a regional organization for the advancement of regional science, in the interest of expanding the pool of future regional science researchers, we will consider a relatively broad range of research topics. The poster session will include a short presentation by each student describing their poster and research, followed by informal browsing and discussion about the posters. Other activities to enhance the experience for the students are also planned.
